



ORDINANCE NO 55, SERIES 2020

CITY OF SYCAMORE, JEFFERSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING LONG-TERM USE OF PARKING SPACES

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Sycamore, Jefferson County, Kentucky has found that it would be in the best interest of the residents of the City to adopt the following Ordinance to establish regulations and related fees for the long-term use of parking spaces.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SYCAMORE, JEFFERSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY THAT THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS AND FEES PERTAINING TO LONG-TERM USE OF PARKING SPACES BE ADOPTED:

SECTION 1 Definitions

- A. Parking Permit is a numbered sticker to be affixed to the rear window, driver's (left) upper or lower side.
- B. Types of Parking Permits
 - 1. Residence Permits -for use on vehicles customarily parked in the unit's assigned spaces. Such permits are not valid for use in guest spaces except during pool or clubhouse usage.
 - 2. Guest Permits – for use on vehicles parked in guest spaces for long periods of time within the city limits.

SECTION 2 Residence Permits: Two (2) Residence Permits will be issued annually to each residence, free of charge, for vehicles to be parked in that residence's assigned spaces. These permits can be replaced for a fee of \$5 or at no cost when a damaged permit is returned.

SECTION 3 Guest Permits and related fees – third, fourth or more vehicles associated with one residence. Purchase of a guest permit entitles the vehicle to be parked in any available guest space but not in a specific space.

- A. Additional Vehicle (1) Resident driver (family member) – Guest Permit fee \$100 annually (must have verification). Ex. 3 resident drivers, 3 vehicles
- B. Additional Vehicle (1) Non-daily driver – Guest Permit fee \$150 annually. Ex. 2 resident drivers, 3 vehicles
- C. Additional Vehicles (2 or more) Non-daily driver – Guest Permit fee \$300 annually.


SECTION 4 Fines and Vehicle Removal: In situations where a guest's vehicle will be parked temporarily within the city limits, but exceeding two days, residents should contact a board member for approval. All vehicles double parked (straddling a guest space line so that the guest space is unavailable) or left unattended in guest spaces without permits, board approval or consent will be subject to fines of \$10 per day and/or removal at the owner's expense.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law, or April 1, 2020 if later.


