

**ADDENDUM
TO
CITY OF SYCAMORE POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This Addendum is to add to City of Sycamore Pool Rules & Regulations the following Kentucky Healthy at Work requirements for opening swimming pools in the year of 2020:

Social Distancing

A maximum of 20 individuals can be in the pool at any time while maintaining a distance of at least 6 feet between individuals who are not members of same household. There can be no sitting on sides of the pool or the steps. Swimmers must be distributed between the shallow end and deep end of pool at 6 feet apart.

All chairs and tables on pool deck are to be spaced 6 feet apart on all sides and are not to be moved.

There will be no congregating of individuals in and around the pool premises.

Restrooms are not to be used for changing rooms. Individuals must arrive in swim attire.

Floating devices (such as air mattresses) cannot be used in pool if it is crowded. This will be decided by lifeguard.

Cleaning and Disinfecting

Individuals will be asked to use hand sanitizer when checking into pool and to wash and sanitize hands frequently.

Pool facilities, such as restrooms, doors, pool handrails and ladders (above water line), deck chairs and tables, are to be disinfected on a regular basis.

Hand sanitizer and diluted household bleach solution will be available on the pool premises and in the restrooms for cleaning and disinfecting.

Toys, noodles and floating devices will not be furnished; individuals bringing their own should disinfect them and take them home.

PPE Requirement

Individuals are encouraged to wear face masks when not in the water and within 6 feet of other individuals who are not members of your household. All individuals are asked to wear masks in the restrooms.

Lifeguards are not required to wear masks while on duty as it is a safety hazard.

Individuals not abiding by City of Sycamore Pool rules and addendum will be asked to leave pool premises.
